Title	Driveway
Category	Mix music program
Schedule	5–7pm <u>, Monday-Friday</u>
Brief Description	Music Mix (bright and up-tempo) including jazz, blues, and folk/world (including R&B/soul/etc. etc.), and some classical, as well as some music from theatre, musicals, popular realms, etc., as long as fresh and not same-old same old.
Concept and Content	Driveway is designed to include all the music styles representative of ArtSound FM's overall sound.
	Majority of audience is driving home from work, relaxing at home, or preparing meals at home.
	In addition to regular news segments, Driveway may include brief audio segments of various kinds, e.g. interviews, event notifications (that day's and perhaps the next's, only; no full Arts Diaries or Exhibition Rundowns) relating to local Music and Arts performers and organisations, along with some community/social-service groups.
	A soft goal of 10% Australian content.
	Each broadcast will ideally have main presenter and support offsider, who may be a trainee mentored by the lead presenter (and phone answerer/runner), which will help to expand the program team. Additions to program team should bring a fresh look to ArtSound programming.
Presentation Style	Bright, welcoming, competent (an emphasis on polished presentation skills, constantly reviewed by the program group).
	Announcements should be brief with quick alerts to other ArtSound programs, occasional time calls, and very occasional, very brief ACT weather updates.

	Live and recorded drop-in segments, such as interviews and prepared features, should be kept to 90 seconds, at most 2 minutes.
Sponsorship and Cross-promotion	According to ArtSound standard operating procedures
Technical requirements	Live from Studio 1 or 3.  Standby pre-recorded programs for each broadcast day to be available at all times, although initially through backup repeats of lunchtime Arts Café broadcasts.
